
Superintendent Updates April 16, 2021

Many of you are aware that our health workers are managing more active cases of COVID-19 given the new variant strain that has emerged in our area. The good news is that the Kalamazoo Health and Community Services Department now has an abundance of vaccine doses and can serve many area residents from the Expo Center location in Kalamazoo.

Our health professionals are now looking for qualified volunteers who can staff the Expo Center for additional clinics in order to speed up the delivery of vaccines to our eligible populations. Just yesterday, they were able to open another clinic that was available to high school students ages 16 and up.

There is a need for many volunteers and there are many roles that need to be filled in order to run a vaccine clinic, such as individuals to sign people in, schedule the second dose and direct people.
