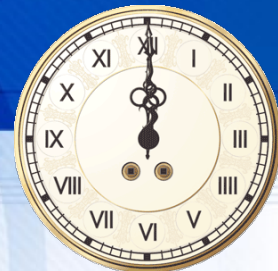

through ISD

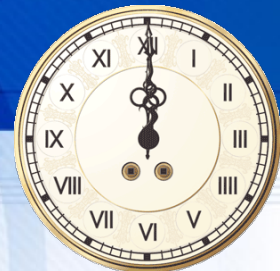
Minimum districts utilize ISD Coach

2017-2018 **Continued**

- Create and Individual Reading Improvement Plans (IRIP) for any K-3 student with a deficiency
- Notify parents and give tools to supports
- Requirement for Principals (PD)
- Use a literacy coach
- Encouraged to Offer Summer reading camps
 - highly effective teacher in

Minimum

- Interventions meet the needs
- Evidenced-based and proven results in accelerating pupil reading
- Small group 1 to 1
- Progress Monitor
- “Read at Home” Plan, including parental supports

2019-2020 School Year

Letter for non-proficient or 1 grade level behind

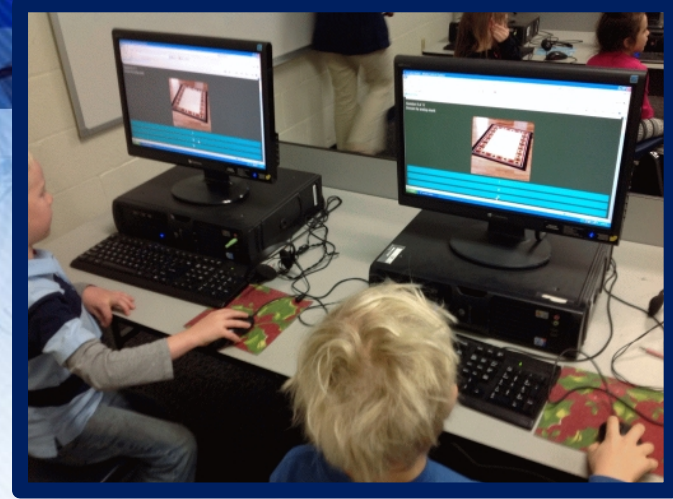
CEPI sends certified letter to families home

Letter does not = retention

If a student can demonstrate proficiency

Proficiency through a portfolio

Only repeating 3rd grade once



Timeline

May 23rd or 14 days after taking test

June 1st, CEPI will send certified mail to household student **may** be required to be retained

Good cause exemption - 30 days - direct request to the district

*IEP team and or 504 coordinator makes the recommendation

*Limited English Proficient = less than 3 years of instruction

Staff PLAN:

Beginning June 4th, 2019

If you can not meet the requirements, a plan must be shared by mid August
